

Beyoncé Giselle Knowles-Carter is an American singer, songwriter, and actress. Beyoncé was born on September 4, 1981, in Houston, Texas.



Her children are Blue Ivy, Rumi, and Sir Carter. She was married to Jay-Z in 2008 and they are still a happy couple.


# Favorite Subjects

Eleven students in AAA preferred Science.





Nine AAA students said that Science was their favorite.
