- **d. MAPS Assessments-** new instrument used for assessment in the fall. Replaces ITBS. Results by end of September/ beginning of October. Scores also used for further assessment of gifted placement. Norm referenced test for Reading, Math also Science for upper grades.
- **e. Dunwoody Cluster -** Letters discussed from Clusters to Dr. Green. All agree Dunwoody should stay within cluster and council will support Dunwoody cluster's decision. Reported that Option A results were overwhelming. We will sit and wait to see not write specific letter from Austin.

## f. PTA/ Foundation Update: Kelly Patilla:

\$140,000 in Foundation donations received as of date which is over budgeted amount of \$129,000. Best fundraising year so far. First year brought in \$100,000. Partners Village Burger and Wing Factory will have family nights. Continue to fund STEM Coordinator Mr. Coleman.
