School Improvement Plan

Guided Reading and Guided Math will continue to be an instructional focus. This will be available on the school's website.

Mrs. Lamas reviewed the School Council Compliance Checklist that she received at the last district training meeting. Training sessions must be done by December 8th. Online options should be available next year so that all members may be trained.

Mrs. Lamas shared that a new person should be nominated as the foundation liaison. Mrs. Lamas and Mrs. Sand nominated themselves for the position. Mrs. Lamas will be the liaison.

CCRPI (College and Career Readiness Performance Index)

Dr. Culbreath shared an article about understanding the CCRPI score and how it is calculated. Dr. Culbreath detailed the initiatives monitored through the building leadership team (BLT). These included programs unique to Austin, including the balanced literacy framework, professional learning communities, Literacy Collaborative framework training, STEM program, Advanced content instructional design, academic mentors for identified students, and reduced class models. All homeroom teachers are either gifted endorsed or working toward obtaining their gifted endorsement.

Austin's CCRPI score dropped as a result of progress points. However, Austin increased in the area of achievement and earned more achievement points. The team spent considerable time examining the CCRPI report and the factors that determine Austin's achievement and progress points versus other schools in the region.
